From now on, we would kindly ask that snacks containing nuts are not brought into school under any circumstances, including as part of your child's lunchbox or for playtime.

I realise that finding potential snacks that are suitable to be brought into school can be a challenge but we would advise all parents to check the ingredients list on packaging for guidance. Any snack items that stipulate 'may contain nuts' or actually contain any type of nut in the ingredients list should be avoided.

As I am sure you all understand, having an allergic reaction of any kind can have very serious consequences and at worst, can be fatal. We would really appreciate your support on this matter so that we can best protect the child in question.
