

PE

EYFS have PE on a Wednesday afternoon. Please ensure your child wears their PE kits to school on this day. Forest Schools will continue to be every Friday afternoon – please can children come to school in their Forest School clothes and bring a **named** bag with their waterproofs, wellies and for any dirty clothes.

Homework

We encourage that every child enjoys a book daily for at least 10 minutes. During the next few weeks your child will bring one book home per week. This book has already been taught at school and we encourage the children to read it at home to gain fluency.

Each term we use the Little Wandle phonics assessment to see how the children are progressing. We then put the sounds and words that you can support your child with learning at home so keep an eye out for these.

Writing

Our phonics scheme is very ambitious and over the next few weeks the children will be using their phonic knowledge to write longer words such as pattern, better, corner, shower.

Understanding the World

The children will also be exploring the natural world around them at forest school.

Reading



The children will be having daily phonics lessons using the programme Little Wandle.

The children will start to learn the diagraphs and trigraphs that the letters make and then to blend these sounds together to make words.

The children will also participate in through reading sessions throughout the week which will be documented in their planners.

To expose the children to a wide variety of books and texts we will have a focus book each week and link lots of our learning to this.

History

Linking to our topic, we will be looking at how has life changed for people. Within this we will be looking at how things have changed within the lives of people that are important to us and before. We will look at different toys and houses.



PSHE

This term we will be understanding drug education which involves learning about our body, what we do when we are poorly and what we can do to stay well. We will also be learning about growing up and the changes from a baby to a child.



Maths

This term the children will be learning about lots of different mathematical concepts. We will be exploring numbers to 10 and within this looking at doubling and odd and even numbers. We will also

As musicians, we will be exploring different types of sounds this half term. We will also be looking at making sounds in different ways.

Design and Technology

This half term we will be learning different skills to help them create old toys.

Within the continuous provision we will also be learning lots of new skills in the creative area such as cutting, sticking and modelling.

PSED

This term we are concentrating on the children confidently trying new activities. We are also helping children build relationships.

RE



This term child will be learning about “What is special in our world?” This investigation enables pupils to experience the nature around them and reflect upon the natural world for themselves. This provides a basis for thinking about how the world was created and understanding that many religious people believe that God designed and created it.
